

Read Genesis 24:42-49

42 “When I came to the spring today, I said, ‘LORD, God of my master Abraham, if you will, please grant success to the journey on which I have come.

43 See, I am standing beside this spring. If a young woman comes out to draw water and I say to her, “Please let me drink a little water from your jar,”

44 and if she says to me, “Drink, and I’ll draw water for your camels too,” let her be the one the LORD has chosen for my master’s son.’

45 “Before I finished praying in my heart, Rebekah came out, with her jar on her shoulder. She went down to the spring and drew water, and I said to her, ‘Please give me a drink.’

46 “She quickly lowered her jar from her shoulder and said, ‘Drink, and I’ll water your camels too.’ So, I drank, and she watered the camels also.

47 “I asked her, ‘Whose daughter are you?’ “She said, “The daughter of Bethuel son of Nahor, whom Milkah bore to him.’ “Then I put the ring in her nose and the bracelets on her arms,

48 and I bowed down and worshiped the LORD. I praised the LORD, the God of my master Abraham, who had led me on the right road to get the granddaughter of my master’s brother for his son.

49 Now if you will show kindness and faithfulness to my master, tell me; and if not, tell me, so I may know which way to turn.”

The servant is continuing to explain to Laban everything that has happened so far in his journey to find a wife for Isaac.

What was the first thing the servant did when he got to the well (v. 42)? He prayed for success in finding a wife for Isaac.

What was the servant’s plan (vv. 43-44)? (Read) Kinda like Gideon’s fleece.

What happened even before the servant had finished praying (v. 45)? Rebekah came out with her water jar on her shoulder.

What did he say to Rebekah? Please give me a drink.

How did Rebekah answer him (v. 46)? Here’s a drink and I’ll water your camels too.

What did the servant do next (v. 47)? He put gold jewelry on her.

After the servant gave Rebekah the jewelry what did he do (v. 48)? He worshipped God and praised Him for leading him to Rebekah who was a member of Abraham’s family.

What did the servant say to Laban (v. 49)? If you are willing to believe me, and do what my master Abraham’s wants, please tell me so I can know what to do next.
