## **Fellowship**

## Read Acts 2:42-47

- **42** All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to prayer.
- **43** A deep sense of awe came over them all, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders.
- **44** And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had.
- **45** They sold their property and possessions and shared the money with those in need.
- **46** They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity —
- **47** all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved.

Sometime after Peter's speech, what did the believers devote themselves to (v. 42)? To the apostles' teaching, and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to prayer. Are these the most important things for a church to do?

**What happened to the believers (v. 43)?** They were filled with a sense of awe of God. They probably were amazed how powerful and loving He was! And the apostles were able to do a lot of miracles, probably like healing people.

What did the believers do next (v. 44)? They met together in one place and shared everything they had.

What did they do after that (v. 45)? They sold their property and possessions and shared the money with those in need.

**What did they do every day (vv. 46-47)?** (Read vv. 46-47a)

**How would you describe this early group of believers?** They were excited, serious about their faith, unselfish, committed, generous, joyful, willing to sacrifice for the Lord, etc. They had a strong fellowship.

**What did God do to honor them?** Every day He added more and more people to their fellowship who were being saved. They were growing like crazy.

Do you think the way they did things is a recipe for church growth today?
