Read Acts 10:17-23a

17 Peter was very perplexed. What could the vision mean? Just then the men sent by Cornelius found Simon's house. Standing outside the gate,

18 they asked if a man named Simon Peter was staying there.

19 Meanwhile, as Peter was puzzling over the vision, the Holy Spirit said to him, "Three men have come looking for you.

20 Get up, go downstairs, and go with them without hesitation. Don't worry, for I have sent them."

21 So Peter went down and said, "I'm the man you are looking for. Why have you come?"

22 They said, "We were sent by Cornelius, a Roman officer. He is a devout and God-fearing man, well respected by all the Jews. A holy angel instructed him to summon you to his house so that he can hear your message."

23a So Peter invited the men to stay for the night.

What was Peter thinking about the vision he had just seen (v. 17)? He couldn't figure out what the vision meant.

What happened while he was thinking? Cornelius's men arrived.

What did Cornelius' men say to the people at the gate (v. 18)? Is Peter staying here?

As Peter was thinking about the vision, what happened (v. 19)? The Holy Spirit spoke to him and told him that three men were waiting for him downstairs.

What did the Holy Spirit tell Peter to do (v. 20)? Go downstairs and go with these men. Don't worry. I am in control. I have sent them here.

What did Peter do (v. 21)? He went downstairs and introduced himself to the men and asked them why they had come.

What did Cornelius' men say to Peter (v. 22)? (Read v. 22) We're on a mission from our master Cornelius. He is a very religious man and all the Jews really respect him. An angel told Cornelius to invite you to his house so he can listen to you preach.

What did Peter do next (v. 23a)? He invited the men to spend the night at Simon's house where he was staying.
